Our Nabi (s) said that the one who will be closer to me will be the one who has sent more darood upon me. In the month of Ramadwaan, our thawaab are doubled. Nafil is equal to 1 fard and 1 fard is equal to 70 fard. The sleep of someone who fasts is ibaadah. When he asks Allah, angels say Ameen. Fishes ask forgiveness for him till Iftar. Allah sent the Qur'an in this bless month and He said in surah Baqarah verse 180: It is prescribed for you, when one of you approached death, if he leave wealth, that he bequeath unto parents and near relatives in kindness. (This is) a duty for all those who ward off (evil). Sayyidouna Abu Sa'eed Al-Khudree (R.A.) narrates that the Prophet said: "When the first night of Ramadwaan dawns, the doors of the skies are opened, and none of its doors are then closed until the last night of Ramadwaan. No believing servant (of Allah) performs Swalaah during its night (any night of Ramadwaan), but Allah will record for him 1500 hasanah (rewards) for every sajdah that he makes. Ramadwaan dawns,

the doors of the skies are opened, and none of its doors are then closed until the last night of Ramadwaan. No believing servant (of Allah) performs Swalaah during its night (any night of Ramadwaan), but Allah will record for him 1500 (rewards) for every sajdah that he makes. And Allah will build a home for him in Jannah made out of red ruby, which will have 60000 doors, each of its doors having (interlinked to, leading to) a palace made out of gold, ornamented (beautified and decorated) with rubies. Thus, when he fasts on the first day of Ramadwaan, all his past sins are pardoned, and seventy thousand angels make Astaghfar for him, daily, from the time of the fajr Swalaah, until the sun sets. And for every sajdah that he makes during Ramadwaan, either by day or by night, there will be for him a tree, (in Jannah, so huge that) a person on horseback will ride in its shade for five hundred years.” It is said that the 10 first days are for Rahman, the next 10 days are for Maghfirah and the last 10 days are for Free from Jahannam.
