



# Umrah Made Easy

## Step No. 1: Preparing For Umrah

1. Perform Ghusl, Wear the *Ihraam* and cover both shoulders and head.
2. Perform 2 Raka'at Swalaat nafil.  
(1<sup>st</sup> Rakaat: surah Faatiha + surah Kaafiroun) and (2<sup>nd</sup> Rakaat: surah Faatiha + surah Ikhlāas)
3. After *Salaam / Tasleem* read Ayat ul Kursiy and Surah Quraish
4. Then uncover the head and formulate the intention - niyyat of *Umrah* :

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أُرِيدُ الْعُمْرَةَ فَيَسِّرْهَا لِي وَ تَقَبَّلْهَا مِنِّي.  
نَوَيْتُ الْعُمْرَةَ وَ أَحْرَمْتُ بِهَا مُخْلِصًا لِلَّهِ تَعَالَى.

*O Allah, I want to perform the Umrah, so make it easy for me and accept it from me. I intended to perform the Umrah and entered ihram with it, sincerely to God Almighty*

5. After Niyyat recite the *Talbiyah* :

لَبَّيْكَ اللَّهُمَّ لَبَّيْكَ لَبَّيْكَ لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ لَبَّيْكَ إِنَّ  
الْحَمْدَ وَ النِّعْمَةَ لَكَ وَ الْمُلْكُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ.

*At your service, O Allah, at your service, at your service, you have no partner, at your service, praise and grace are yours, and the kingdom is yours, you have no partner.*

6. After the *Talbiyah*, read *Darood Shareef* and the following du'a :

اَللّٰهُمَّ اِنِّىْ اَسْأَلُكَ رِضَاكَ وَ الْجَنَّةَ وَ اَعُوْذُ بِرَحْمَتِكَ  
مِنَ النَّارِ.

*O Allah, I ask You for Your satisfaction and Paradise, and I seek refuge in Your mercy from Hell.*

7. Men read the *Talbiyah* aloud and women read it in their hearts.

### Step No. 2: Leaving Home For Umrah

Leaving home, read Surah Qadr and this du'a :

بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ وَ لَا حَوْلَ وَ لَا قُوَّةَ اِلَّا بِاللّٰهِ الْعَلِيِّ الْعَظِيْمِ.  
تَوَكَّلْتُ عَلَى اللّٰهِ. اَللّٰهُمَّ وَفِّقْنِيْ لِمَا تُحِبُّ وَ تَرْضٰى  
وَ احْفَظْنِيْ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيْمِ.

*In the name of God, and there is neither might nor power except with God, the Most High, the Great. I put my trust in God. O Allah, grant me success in what You love and are pleased with, and protect me from the accursed Shaitan.*

### Step No. 3: Entering Haram Shareef

Enter *Makkah Mukarramah* with humility and *Masjid ul Haram* with the right foot and recite:

اَللّٰهُمَّ اِنَّ هٰذَا حَرَمُكَ وَ حَرَمُ رَسُوْلِكَ فَحَرِّمْ لِحْمِي  
وَ دَمِي وَ عَظْمِي عَلَى النَّارِ. اَللّٰهُمَّ اَمِنِّيْ مِنْ عَذَابِكَ  
يَوْمَ تَبْعَثُ عِبَادَكَ. وَ اجْعَلْنِيْ مِنْ اَوْلِيَّائِكَ وَ اَهْلِ  
طَاعَتِكَ وَ تُبِّ عَلَيَّ اِنَّكَ اَنْتَ التَّوَّابُ الرَّحِيْمُ.

*O Allah! Indeed, this is Your sacred sanctuary and the sanctuary of Your Messenger. So make my flesh, my blood, and my bones forbidden to the Fire. O Allah! Grant me safety from Your punishment on the Day You resurrect Your servants. And make me among Your friends (awliyā') and the people of Your obedience, and accept my repentance — indeed, You are the Most Forgiving, the Most Merciful.*

#### Step No. 4: Seeing Ka'bah Shareef

On seeing the *Baitullah* (ka'bah Shareef), recite:

اَللّٰهُ اَكْبَرُ اَللّٰهُ اَكْبَرُ لَا اِلٰهَ اِلَّا اللّٰهُ وَ اللّٰهُ اَكْبَرُ اَللّٰهُ اَكْبَرُ وَ  
لِلّٰهِ الْحَمْدُ. اَللّٰهُمَّ اَنْتَ السَّلَامُ وَ مِنْكَ السَّلَامُ فَحَيِّنَا  
رَبَّنَا بِالسَّلَامِ. اَللّٰهُمَّ زِدْ هٰذَا الْبَيْتَ تَشْرِيفًا وَ تَعْظِيْمًا وَ  
تَكْرِيْمًا وَ مَهَابَةً وَ زِدْ مَنْ شَرَّفَهُ وَ كَرَّمَهُ مِمَّنْ حَجَّهٗ اَوْ  
اعْتَمَرَهُ تَشْرِيفًا وَ تَعْظِيْمًا وَ تَكْرِيْمًا وَ بَرًّا.

*Allah is the Greatest, Allah is the Greatest. There is no deity except Allah, and Allah is the Greatest, Allah is the Greatest, and all praise belongs to Allah. O Allah! You are the Source of Peace, and from You is peace. So, grant us, our Lord, life in peace. O Allah! Increase this House [the Ka'bah] in honor, greatness, dignity, and awe. And increase those who honor and venerate it — whether by performing Hajj or Umrah — in honor, greatness, dignity, and righteousness.*

### **Du'a When Seeing The ka'bah**

**Sayyidunā ‘Abdul Qādir al-Jīlānī (رحمه الله):**

“When you look at the Ka'bah, do not see a structure of stone — see the secret of His majesty, the door of His mercy, and the mirror of His light.” Read :

اَللّٰهُمَّ اجْعَلْ نَظْرِيْ اِلَى الْكَعْبَةِ نَظْرًا اِلَيْكَ وَ قُلُوْبِيْ  
مُتَوَجِّهًا اِلَيْكَ وَ نَفْسِيْ سَاكِنَةً لِّرِضَاكَ.

“O Allah, make my gaze upon the Ka'bah a gaze towards You; let my heart turn wholly toward You; let my soul rest only in Your pleasure.”

**Imām al-Ghazālī (رحمه الله):**

“When you see the Ka'bah, know that your eyes are upon the House, but the heart must see the Lord of the House.” Read:

اَللّٰهُمَّ هَذَا بَيْتُكَ وَ اَنَا عَبْدُكَ ، جِئْتُكَ مِنْ بَعِيْدٍ اَطْلُبُ  
رِضَاكَ ، فَاقْبَلْنِيْ قَبُوْلًا يَلِيْقُ بِكَرَمِكَ ، لَا بِعَمَلِيْ.

*“O Allah, this is Your House and I am Your servant. I have come from afar seeking Your pleasure — so accept me with a reception befitting Your generosity, not my deeds.”*

**Sayyid Ahmad al-Rifā'ī (قدس سره):**

*“The Ka‘bah is the qiblah of the body, but Allah is the qiblah of the heart.”*

اَللّٰهُمَّ اجْعَلْنِيْ مِنْ اَهْلِ هَذَا الْبَيْتِ فِي الدُّنْيَا وَالْاٰخِرَةِ، وَ  
اجْعَلْنِيْ مِمَّنْ يَرَاكَ قَبْلَ اَنْ يَّرَى الْكَعْبَةَ.

*“O Allah, make me among the people of this House in this world and the next, and make me among those who see You before seeing the Ka‘bah.”*

**Imām Ibn ‘Atā’illāh al-Iskandarī (رحمه الله)**

*“When you behold the Ka‘bah, remember that Allah commanded Ibrāhīm to ‘purify My House’ — so cleanse your own heart, for it too is a House of Allah.”*

اَللّٰهُمَّ اَقِمْ قَلْبِيْ كَمَا اَقَمْتَ الْكَعْبَةَ ، وَ طَهِّرْ سِرِّيْ كَمَا  
طَهَّرْتَ بَيْتَكَ الْحَرَامَ.

*“O Allah, make my heart stand upright as You have raised the Ka‘bah, and purify my inner secret as You purified Your Sacred House.”*

**Mawlānā Jalāluddīn Rūmī (رحمه الله)**

*“When you reach the Ka‘bah, seek not the stones — Seek the Face toward which the stones bow. The Ka‘bah is the veil; the Beloved is beyond.”*

اَللّٰهُمَّ اَرِنَا وَجْهَكَ الْكَرِيْمَ مِنْ وَّرَاءِ سُتُوْر الْكَوْنِ.

*“O Allah, show us Your Noble Face beyond the veils of creation.”*

**The ‘Ārifīn :**

اَللّٰهُمَّ اجْعَلْنِيْ مِمَّنْ اِذَا نَظَرَ اِلَى الْكَعْبَةِ ، رَأَى نُوْرَكَ ،  
وَإِذَا سَجَدَ ، شَهِدَ قُرْبَكَ، وَإِذَا دَعَاكَ، أَجَبْتَهُ بِلَبَّيْكَ.

*“O Allah, make me among those who, when they look at the Ka‘bah, see Your Light; when they prostrate, feel Your nearness; and when they call upon You, hear You say: Labbayk!”*

اَللّٰهُمَّ اجْعَلْنِيْ مُسْتَجَابَ الدَّعَوَاتِ.

*O Allah, make me among those whose supplications are answered.*

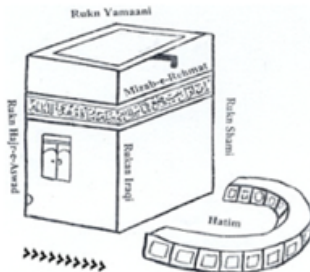
اَللّٰهُمَّ اجْعَلْنِيْ مُسْتَجَابَ الدَّعَوَاتِ ، مَقْبُوْلَ الطَّاعَاتِ ،  
مَغْفُوْرَ الزَّلَّاتِ ، مَحْبُوْبًا عِنْدَكَ وَ عِنْدَ اَوْلِيَائِكَ ، وَ  
مُقَرَّبًا اِلَيْكَ فِي الدُّنْيَا وَ الْآخِرَةِ .

*O Allah, make me among those whose supplications are answered, whose acts of worship are accepted, whose slips and faults are forgiven, beloved to You and to Your friends, and brought near to You in this world and the Hereafter.*

اَللّٰهُمَّ اجْعَلْ قَلْبِيْ مَحَلَّ نَظْرِكَ ، وَ لِسَانِيْ مَجْرَى ذِكْرِكَ  
، وَ نَفْسِيْ مَحَطَّ رِضَاكَ ، وَ رُوْحِيْ مَسْكَنَ حُبِّكَ .

*O Allah, make my heart the place of Your gaze, my tongue the flow of Your remembrance, my soul the station of Your pleasure, and my spirit the dwelling of Your love.*

### Step No. 5: Niyyat At Hajar ul Aswad



1. Uncover the right shoulder only.



2. Start *Tawaaf* from *Hajarul Aswad* towards *Hatim*.
3. Face *Hajar ul Aswad* and perform *Niyyah* as follows :

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أُرِيدُ طَوَافَ بَيْتِكَ الْحَرَامِ سَبْعَةَ أَشْوَاطٍ لِلَّهِ تَعَالَى  
فَيَسِّرْهُ لِي وَتَقَبَّلْهُ مِنِّي.

*O Allah! I intend to perform seven circuits (Tawāf) of Your Sacred House for Your sake, so make it easy for me and accept it from me.*

4. Kiss the *Hajar ul Aswad* if possible or from where one stands, raise the 2 hands till the level of the ears, the palm of the hands facing the *Hajar ul Aswad* and the *Ka'bah Shareef* and read :

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ وَ لِلَّهِ الْحَمْدُ.

*In the Name of Allah, Allah is the Greatest, and all praise is for Allah.*

5. Then lower the hands and do *Istilam* (kissing) of the *Hajar ul Aswad*. If it is impossible to kiss the *Hajar ul Aswad*, then do it through sign and kiss the hands. Then recite:

اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَ الصَّلَاةُ وَ السَّلَامُ عَلَى رَسُولِ  
اللَّهِ.

*Allah is the Greatest. There is no deity except Allah, and may prayers and peace be upon the Messenger of Allah.*

## Step No. 6: Tawaaf Of Ka’bah Shareef

1. In the first 3 rounds, perform *Idtiba*, that is, cover the left shoulder and uncover the right one. Pass the *Ihraam* under the right armpit. There is *ikhtilaaf*, that is, difference of opinion where the right shoulder is uncovered for all 7 rounds. Both are acceptable.
2. Must perform *Ramal* (walk rapidly with long steps) in the first 3 rounds only then walk naturally as from the 4<sup>th</sup> round till the end of the *Tawaaf*. If not possible, due to crowd, then walk at ease for all 7 rounds.
3. If wudhu is nullified within the first 3 rounds, wudhu must be done again and start 1<sup>st</sup> round again.
4. If wudhu is nullified after the 3<sup>rd</sup> round (that is at least on the 4<sup>th</sup> round), then perform wudhu and continue as from the round the wudhu was nullified.
5. It is more virtuous to ask any du’a during *tawaaf* than reciting the *Qur'an* or *Talbiyah*.
6. It is Sunnah to touch *Rukn ul Yamani* with the 2 hands or with the right hand. But nowadays where there is perfume being spread on the ka’bah, it is better to avoid when in the state of *Ihraam*.

### Tasbihaat In Each Round – Read 1 Tasbih Per Round

1. بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ. أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ رَبِّي مِنْ كُلِّ ذَنْبٍ وَ أَتُوبُ إِلَيْهِ.

*In the Name of Allah, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. I seek forgiveness from Allah, my Lord, for every sin, and I turn to Him in repentance.*

2. لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ مُحَمَّدٌ رَّسُولُ اللَّهِ ﷺ .

*There is no deity except Allah, Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah ﷺ.*

3. حَسْبِيَ اللَّهُ وَ نِعْمَ الْوَكِيلُ نِعْمَ الْمَوْلَى وَ نِعْمَ النَّصِيرُ.

*Allah is sufficient for me, and He is the best Disposer of affairs, the best Protector, and the best Helper.*

4. لَا حَوْلَ وَ لَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ الْعَلِيِّ الْعَظِيمِ.

*There is no power and no strength except with Allah, the Most High, the Most Great.*

5. اللَّهُ رَبِّي لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ.

*Allah is my Lord; He has no partner.*

6. يَا اللَّهُ يَا رَحْمَنُ يَا رَحِيمُ.

*O Allah, O Most Gracious, O Most Merciful.*

*O Allah, to You belongs all thanks.*

**Step No. 7: Du'a At Hajar ul Aswad & Rukn ul Yamani**

1. From *Hajar ul Aswad* to *Rukn ul Yamaani* read :

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ ، وَ الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ ، وَ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ ، وَ اللَّهُ  
أَكْبَرُ ، وَ لَا حَوْلَ وَ لَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ.

*Glory be to Allah, and all praise is for Allah, and there is no deity except Allah, and Allah is the Greatest, and there is no power nor strength except with Allah.*

2. From *Rukn ul Yamaani* to *Hajar ul Aswad* read :

رَبَّنَا آتِنَا فِي الدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً وَ فِي الْآخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَ قِنَا  
عَذَابَ النَّارِ وَ ادْخِلْنَا الْجَنَّةَ مَعَ الْأَبْرَارِ يَا رَبَّ  
الْعَالَمِينَ.

*Our Lord, grant us good in this world and good in the Hereafter, and protect us from the punishment of the Fire, and admit us to Paradise with the righteous, O Lord of the worlds.*

## Step No. 8: Du'a At Multazam

After the 7<sup>th</sup> round and *Istilam*, go to *Multazam* (between *Hajar ul Aswad* and the door of the Ka'bah) and recite:

اَللّٰهُمَّ يَا رَبَّ الْبَيْتِ الْعَتِيقِ اَعْتِقْ رِقَابَنَا وَ رِقَابَ آبَائِنَا وَ  
اُمَمَاتِنَا وَ اِخْوَانِنَا وَ اَوْلَادِنَا مِنَ النَّارِ يَا ذَا الْجُودِ وَ  
الْكَرَمِ وَ الْفَضْلِ وَ الْمَنِّ وَ الْعَطَاءِ وَ الْاِحْسَانِ. اَللّٰهُمَّ  
اَحْسِنْ عَاقِبَتِنَا فِي الْاُمُورِ كُلِّهَا وَ اَجِرْنَا مِنْ خِزْيِ الدُّنْيَا  
وَ عَذَابِ الْاٰخِرَةِ. اَللّٰهُمَّ اِنِّي عَبْدُكَ وَ ابْنُ عَبْدِكَ وَاقِفٌ  
تَحْتَ بَابِكَ مُلتَزِمٌ بِاَعْتَابِكَ مُتَدَلِّلٌ بَيْنَ يَدَيْكَ، اَرْجُو  
رَحْمَتَكَ وَ اَخْشَى عَذَابَكَ يَا قَدِيْمَ الْاِحْسَانِ. اَللّٰهُمَّ اِنِّي  
اَسْأَلُكَ اَنْ تَرْفَعَ ذِكْرِي، وَ تَضَعَ وَزْرِي، وَ تُصْلِحَ اَمْرِي،  
وَ تُطَهِّرَ قَلْبِي، وَ تُنَوِّرَ لِي فِي قَبْرِي، وَ تَغْفِرَ لِي ذَنْبِي وَ  
اَسْأَلُكَ الدَّرَجَاتِ الْعُلَى مِنَ الْجَنَّةِ.

*O Allah, O Lord of the Ancient House, free our necks and  
the necks of our fathers, mothers, brothers, and children  
from the Fire, O Possessor of Generosity, Bounty,*

*Excellence, Grace, Giving, and Kindness. O Allah, make the outcome of our affairs good in all matters, and protect us from the disgrace of this world and the punishment of the Hereafter. O Allah, I am Your servant and the son of Your servant, standing at Your door, holding firmly to Your thresholds, humbling myself before You. I hope for Your mercy and fear Your punishment, O Eternal Bestower of Goodness. O Allah, I ask You to raise my mention, remove my burdens, rectify my affairs, purify my heart, illuminate my grave, forgive my sins, and grant me the highest ranks in Paradise.*

### **Step No. 9: Maqaam ul Ibrahim (as)**

1. Then go to *Maqaam ul Ibrahim (as)* and recite :

وَ اتَّخِذُوا مِنْ مَّقَامِ إِبْرَاهِيمَ مُصَلًّى .

*And take the station of Abraham as a place of prayer.*

2. Then perform 2 Raka'at Swalaat Nafil. (*Alham + Surah Kaafiroun* and then *Alham + Surah Ikhlās*).
3. After *Salaam / Tasleem* make du'a :

اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّكَ تَعْلَمُ سِرِّي وَ عَلَيَّ نِيَّتِي فَأَقْبَلْ مَعْدِرَتِي وَ تَعْلَمُ

حَاجَتِي فَأَعْطِنِي سُؤْلِي وَ تَعْلَمُ مَا فِي نَفْسِي فَأَغْفِرْ لِي

ذُنُوبِي، اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ إِيمَانًا يُبَاشِرُ قَلْبِي وَ يَقِينًا

صَادِقًا حَتَّى أَعْلَمَ أَنَّهُ لَا يُصِيبُنِي إِلَّا مَا كَتَبْتَ وَ رِضَاءً

بِمَا قَسَمْتَ لِي. أَنْتَ وَلِيِّي فِي الدُّنْيَا وَ الْآخِرَةِ تَوَفَّنِي  
 مُسْلِمًا وَ أَلْحِقْنِي بِالصَّالِحِينَ. اَللّٰهُمَّ لَا تَدَعْ لَنَا فِي  
 مَقَامِنَا هَذَا ذَنْبًا إِلَّا غَفَرْتَهُ وَ لَا هَمًّا إِلَّا فَرَّجْتَهُ وَ لَا  
 حَاجَةً إِلَّا قَضَيْتَهَا وَ يَسِّرْهَا فَيَسِّرْ أُمُورَنَا وَ اشْرَحْ  
 صُدُورَنَا وَ نَوِّرْ قُلُوبَنَا وَ اخْتِم بِالصَّالِحَاتِ أَعْمَالَنَا.  
 اَللّٰهُمَّ تَوَفَّنَا مُسْلِمِينَ وَ أَلْحِقْنَا بِالصَّالِحِينَ غَيْرَ خَزَايَا وَ  
 لَا مَفْتُونِينَ.

*O Allah, You know my secret and my intention, so accept my excuse. You know my need, so grant me what I ask. You know what is in my soul, so forgive my sins. O Allah, I ask You for faith that touches my heart, and for true certainty, so that I know nothing will befall me except what You have decreed, and contentment with what You have apportioned for me. You are my Protector in this world and the Hereafter; let me die as a Muslim and join me with the righteous. O Allah, leave no sin for us in this place except that You forgive it, no worry except that You relieve it, no need except that You fulfil and ease it. Make our affairs easy, open our hearts, enlighten our hearts, and seal our deeds with righteousness. O Allah, let us die as Muslims*

*and join us with the righteous, without disgrace and without being led astray.*

### **Step No. 10: Water Zam Zam**

Then move towards water zam zam, face the Ka'bah Shareef and drink in 3 steps while reciting *Bismillah* and :

اَللّٰهُمَّ اِنِّیْ اَسْأَلُكَ عِلْمًا نَافِعًا وَ رِزْقًا وَاسِعًا وَ  
شِفَاءً مِّنْ كُلِّ دَآءٍ.

*O Allah, I ask You for beneficial knowledge, abundant provision, and healing from every illness.*

It is recommended, if possible, to pour a little of the water zam zam on one's head as a Sunnah.

### **Step No. 11: Sa'iy**

Proceed to Mount *Safa*. Reaching there, face the Ka'bah Shareef and perform the Niyyat :

اَللّٰهُمَّ اِنِّیْ اُرِیْدُ السَّعٰی بَیْنَ الصَّفَا وَ الْمَرْوَةِ سَبْعَةَ  
اَشْوَاطٍ لِلّٰهِ تَعَالٰی فَيَسِّرْهُ لِیْ وَ تَقَبَّلْهُ مِنِّیْ.

*O Allah, I intend to perform seven circuits of Sa'i between Safā and Marwah for Your sake; so make it easy for me and accept it from me.*



(\*\*\*) Read the following verse (2: 158):

إِنَّ الصَّفَا وَ الْمَرْوَةَ مِنْ شَعَائِرِ اللَّهِ فَمَنْ حَجَّ الْبَيْتَ أَوْ  
اعْتَمَرَ فَلَا جُنَاحَ عَلَيْهِ أَنْ يَطَّوَّفَ بِهِمَا وَ مَنْ تَطَوَّعَ  
خَيْرًا فَإِنَّ اللَّهَ شَاكِرٌ عَلِيمٌ.

*Indeed, Ṣafā and Marwah are among the symbols of Allah. So whoever performs Hajj or 'Umrah to the House, there is no sin upon him to perform Sa'i between them. And whoever does good voluntarily, then indeed Allah is All-Recognizing, All-Knowing.*

(\*\*\*) Then recite Darood Shareef and 3 times with audible voice :

اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ وَ لِلَّهِ الْحَمْدُ.

*Allah is the Greatest, Allah is the Greatest, Allah is the Greatest, and all praise is for Allah.*

(\*\*\*) Then recite 3 times :

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَ لَهُ  
الْحَمْدُ وَ هُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ.

*There is no deity except Allah alone; He has no partner.  
His is the dominion, and His is all praise, and He is over all  
things capable.*

(\*\*\*) Also recite :

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ أَنْجَزَ وَعْدَهُ وَ نَصَرَ عَبْدَهُ وَ  
هَزَمَ الْأَحْزَابَ وَحْدَهُ.

*There is no deity except Allah alone; He fulfilled His  
promise, helped His servant, and defeated the confederates  
by Himself.*

(\*\*\*) Recite the following and then *Darood Shareef* :

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَ الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ وَ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ  
وَ لَا حَوْلَ وَ لَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ.

*Glory be to Allah, and all praise is for Allah, and there is  
no deity except Allah, and Allah is the Greatest, and there  
is no power nor strength except with Allah.*

Start walking towards *Marwa* in *Dhikrullaah* and read:

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَ لَهُ  
الْحَمْدُ وَ هُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ.

*There is no deity except Allah alone; He has no partner.  
His is the dominion, and His is all praise, and He is over all  
things capable.*

In between the 2 green lights, men must run but women must walk naturally reciting:

رَبِّ اغْفِرْ وَارْحَمْ إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ الْأَعَزُّ الْأَكْرَمُ.

*My Lord, forgive and have mercy, for You are the Most  
Mighty, the Most Generous.*

1. Reaching Mount *Marwa* makes it 1<sup>st</sup> round. From *Marwa* to *Safa* again makes the 2<sup>nd</sup> round. It goes on till the 7th round on *Marwa*.
2. Each time on *Safa* and *Marwa*, read again as from Pg 16 with all markings (\*\*\*)
3. Reaching *Marwa* at the end of the 7<sup>th</sup> round, it is mustahab to perform 2 Raka'at swalaat Nafil.
4. Then men must either shave the whole head (known as *Halq*) or perform *Qasr* that is cut the hair short with 1-inch length (finger-joint) or lesser or ¼ of the head. Women cut only a lock of their hair (1-inch length).

### **Entering Madinat ul Munawwarah**

Enter Madina with Darood and say the following supplication:

اَللّٰهُمَّ هٰذَا حَرَمٌ نَّبِيِّكَ فَاجْعَلْهُ وَقَايَةً لِّيْ مِنَ النَّارِ وَ اٰمِنًا  
مِّنَ الْعَذَابِ وَ سُوءِ الْحِسَابِ.

*O Allah, this is the sanctuary of Your Prophet, so make it a protection for me from the Fire, and grant us safety from punishment and the evil of reckoning.*

Following your entrance into the Mosque, ensure you follow the regular etiquette of entering the mosque - Enter with the right foot and recite the supplication:

بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ مَا شَاءَ اللّٰهُ لَا قُوَّةَ اِلَّا بِاللّٰهِ رَبِّ اَدْخِلْنِيْ مُدْخَلَ  
صِدْقٍ وَ اَخْرِجْنِيْ مُخْرَجَ صِدْقٍ ، اَللّٰهُمَّ افْتَحْ لِيْ اَبْوَابَ  
رَحْمَتِكَ وَ ارْزُقْنِيْ مِنْ زِيَارَةِ رَسُوْلِكَ (ﷺ) مَا رَزَقْتَ  
اَوْلِيَائِكَ وَ اَهْلَ طَاعَتِكَ وَ انْقِذْنِيْ مِنَ النَّارِ وَ اغْفِرْ لِيْ  
وَ ارْحَمْنِيْ يَا خَيْرَ مَسْئُوْلٍ. بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ، اَللّٰهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلٰى  
مُحَمَّدٍ ﷺ. اَللّٰهُمَّ اغْفِرْ لِيْ وَافْتَحْ لِيْ اَبْوَابَ رَحْمَتِكَ.

*In the Name of Allah, what Allah wills. There is no power except with Allah. My Lord, admit me with a truthful entrance and let me exit with a truthful exit. O Allah, open*

*for me the doors of Your mercy and grant me the blessing of visiting Your Messenger (ﷺ), as You have granted to Your friends and the obedient. Save me from the Fire, forgive me, and have mercy on me, O Best of those asked.*

*In the Name of Allah, O Allah, send blessings upon Muhammad ﷺ. O Allah, forgive me and open for me the doors of Your mercy.*

And after you have done so, give the Prophet ﷺ your greetings of peace, the minimum is:

السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكَ أَيُّهَا النَّبِيُّ وَرَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ وَبَرَكَاتُهُ. السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكَ

يَا رَسُولَ اللَّهِ. السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكَ يَا خَيْرَ خَلْقِ اللَّهِ. السَّلَامُ

عَلَيْكَ يَا شَفِيعَ الْمُذْنِبِينَ. السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكَ وَ عَلَى آلِكَ وَ

أَصْحَابِكَ وَ أُمَّتِكَ أَجْمَعِينَ.

*Peace be upon you, O Prophet, and the mercy of Allah and His blessings. Peace be upon you, O Messenger of Allah.*

*Peace be upon you, O best of Allah's creation. Peace be upon you, O intercessor for the sinners. Peace be upon you and upon your family, your companions, and your entire community.*

And after you have done so, when you pass by Rasulullaah ﷺ, give the Prophet ﷺ your greetings of peace, the minimum is:

السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكَ يَا رَسُولَ اللَّهِ ﷺ.

*Peace be upon you, O Messenger of Allah ﷺ.*

And after you have done so, give Sayyidouna Abu Bakr Siddiq (ra) your greetings of peace, the minimum is:

السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكَ يَا أَبَا بَكْرٍ الصِّدِّيقُ.

*Peace be upon you, O Abu Bakr As-Siddiq.*

And after you have done so, give Sayyidouna ‘Umar al Khattab (ra) your greetings of peace, the minimum is:

السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكَ يَا عُمَرُ بْنُ الْخَطَّابِ.

*Peace be upon you, O ‘Umar ibn Al-Khaṭṭāb.*

**Du’a When Presenting In front Of Rasulullaah (ﷺ)**

**Imām al-Ghazālī (رحمه الله):**
